- To share ideas between delegates to support evidence collection;
- To cross reference evidence examples from different schools to ensure consistent standards;
- How to make moderation evidence collection straightforward and linked into everyday work;
- How to present evidence to ensure coverage and 100% fit (with a flexible approach where appropriate).

<u>NB:</u> Delegates will need to bring some examples of writing at WTS, EXS and GDS with them to the workshop, along with the exemplifications for KS2 writing (either paper or ICT based).
